Telling Family

When I returned to the United Kingdom from my trip to SCOAN, I was still processing my profound spiritual experience while meditating and praying at the altar.

Although I wanted to share what happened with the Church, I initially decided to keep it to myself because I was still meditating about my experience.

The vision of the Angels dancing joyfully in circles on the altar and seeing Jesus standing tall on the altar was very personal and deeply meaningful to me.

I shared my experience and vision at SCOAN with my husband and some family members.





I described seeing the Angels gracefully dancing in circles, the circle splitting, and how they formed the circle back again perfectly.

I mentioned the brightness on the altar where Jesus was standing. I shared sensing Jesus' presence and noticing the scar on His feet.

My experience strengthened my faith and trust in God.

Emailing the Church

After returning to the United Kingdom, I emailed the church office at SCOAN to share my fantastic experience at the altar.

I described in detail the visions, as I wanted the church to know about my spiritual encounter while meditating and praying at the altar.

Sending that email was a big step for me, as I am usually private regarding spiritual matters.

However, I felt compelled in my heart to tell SCOAN about my experience. I knew my story could potentially help build the faith of others.

Phone Call from Prophet TB Joshua

After I emailed the church about my experience there, I got several phone calls from the church office one evening, but then I was at the gym.

My husband answered and told them I was at the gym, so they said they would call back later.

At midnight, at about 12 a.m., I got a call from the Church. A male evangelist passed the phone to Prophet TB Joshua, and he said, "I usually wake you up at this time to pray."

I was shocked and speechless because I never expected to speak to such an anointed man of God.

Prophet TB Josuah spoke with me on the phone. He said, "I know what you saw.

There is a reason why God has decided to show you this vision and reveal it to you."

He also said, "Spend time to meditate and ask God why he revealed this to you."

This personal revelation from the Lord is the only sure way to know the truth. Let Him guide you continually into greater understanding, spiritual growth and freedom.
